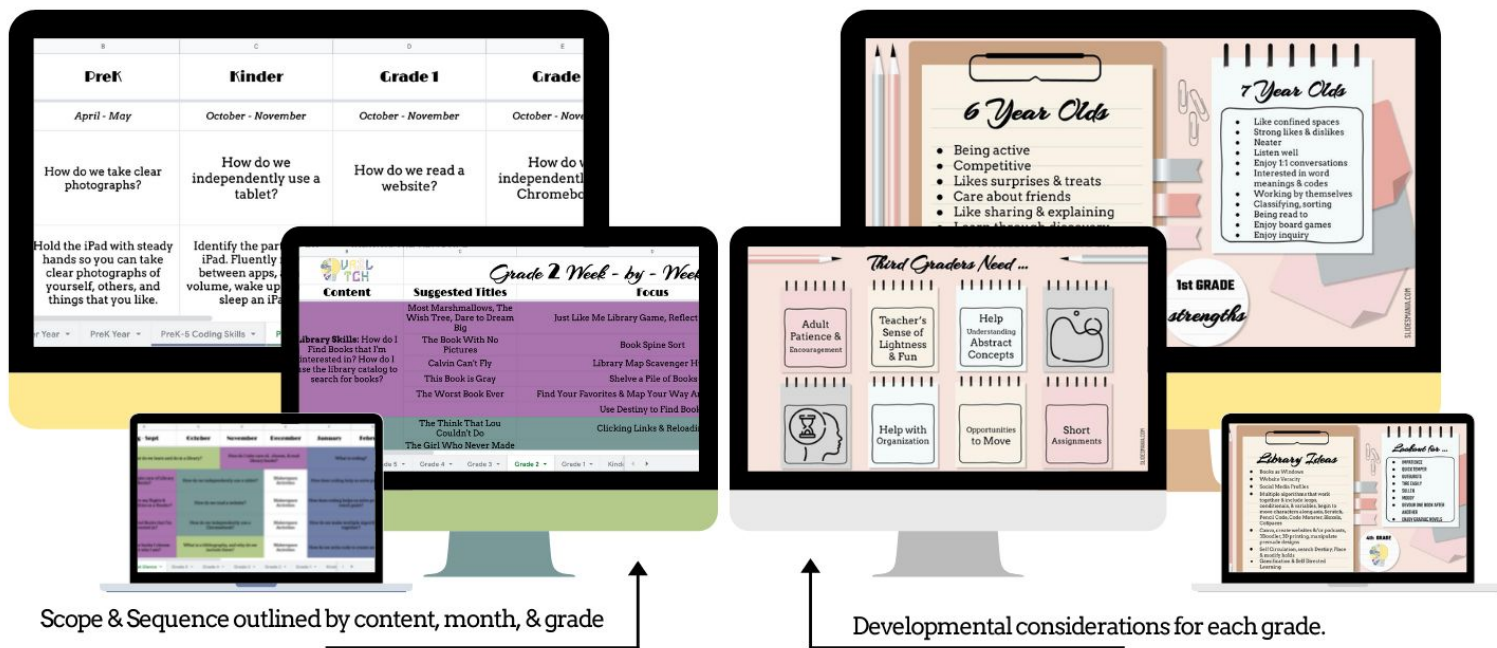
- Triple click on the vocabulary word to highlight it blue.
